BREAKFAST CLUB AND AFTER SCHOOL CLUB

We are delighted to inform you about our **“Breakfast Club”** at LND. This is available to all School pupils from Nursery through to Upper VI. The breakfast offered includes a bacon or sausage bap, and a drink or cereal and toast with a drink. Healthy yoghurts, fruit and smoothies are also available. **Parents** are welcome to grab a “take away” or stay for the “Full English” available each Friday morning for £2.50!

JUNIOR SCHOOL

Junior School pupils need to be dropped off in the Senior School at 8.00am, where they will be met in the Dining Room by the Junior School Classroom Assistants. They will then register your children, supervise them whilst they have breakfast and then accompany the whole group back to the Junior School site for another registration. The Junior School children sit in a separate area to the Senior School students and are supervised with a ratio of 1:6 for Nursery and Reception children, and 1:10 for 6-11 year olds. Please enquire in the Junior School Office for costs and forms.

“TeaRex” After School Club is available to all **Junior School children** from Nursery to Year 6. This is available from Mondays to Fridays and has its own dedicated room in Orchard Lodge. The Club is committed to the children having fun and relaxing through a variety of activities they can choose from. Children have the opportunity to be active outside, to be creative, to use the computer, and to play with a range of games and construction toys. There are some games and activities for older pupils too, as well as the use of the computer. They can, of course, sit and do their homework. A light tea is offered and the sandwiches are refrigerated until they are ready to eat them. The children eat their tea together in the Dining Hall.

SENIOR SCHOOL

For **Senior School pupils**, the Breakfast Club opens daily at 7.50am. Pupils may pay with cash on a daily basis.

We ask that **Senior School pupils** are collected from school at 3.40pm unless they are staying for an after school activity. Lists of clubs vary each term and are available from the Senior School Office. The library is available after school for homework. This is supervised by a qualified first-aider until 5.00pm each day. Years 10 and 11 are also welcome to join the homework club after school until 5.00pm.

For safety reasons, no pupil is permitted to remain unsupervised in the school buildings/grounds after 3.40pm.
